Harry Potter Mania

Harry Potter is a series of seven fantasy novels written (1) British author J. K. Rowling. The books chronicle the adventures of the adolescent wizard Harry Potter, together (2) Ron Weasley and Hermione Granger, his friends from the Hogwarts School of Witchcraft and Wizardry. The story (3) around Harry's struggle against the evil wizard Lord Voldemort, who killed Harry's parents in his quest to conquer the wizarding world and subjugate the non-magical humans, called “muggles” to his evil rule.

Since the 1997 (4) of the first novel - Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone, which was retitled Harry Potter and the Sorcerer's Stone in the United States, the books have (5) immense popularity, critical acclaim and commercial success worldwide.

The series has sold (6) than 400 million copies and has been translated into 67 languages, and the last four books have consecutively (7) records as the fastest-selling books in history.
